DREAM COME TRUE

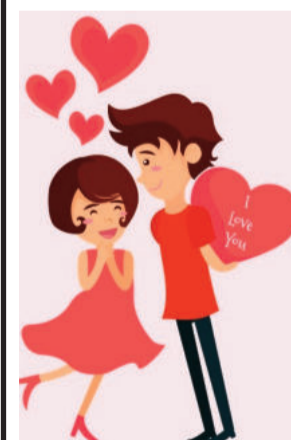
